CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

A proposed timetable has been set out by the Prime Minister in his Covid-19 Response - Spring 2021 document, which presents the step-by-step roadmap to reopening in England.

When can bands rehearse again?

Non-professional activity will be able to resume during Step 3, which is planned to happen *no earlier* than 17 May. This will be in line with social contact rules. Indoors the rule of 6 (or 2 households) will still apply but most restrictions on meeting outdoors will be lifted. At this time we should be able to restart rehearsals in groups of 6.

Step 4 is planned for not before 21 June when the Government hopes to remove all legal limits on social contacts. So we should then be able to get back to normal(ish) rehearsals
